A surprising opportunity opens for EIN

September was a most unusual month. With back surgery looming for Pastor Andy, EIN still managed to make it to a conference in North Carolina and to a hurricane in South Carolina before his date with a surgeon in Alabama!

Because of the hurricane in South Carolina, attendance really took a hit at Kelleytown Baptist Church. However, in the midst of rain, wind and threatening floods, a group of traveling seminary students from Zambia was also stuck in the area. With some of their own events canceled, they came to our conference three straight nights.

The Zambian group took a great interest in the concept of using video from the land of the Bible to teach the Bible to their own congregations. Part of the reason? They'd all just been given projectors for their own ministries through a \$100,000 grant from Liberty University! All of the students at the seminary are about to add a visual element to their preaching and teaching in South Africa!

The end of a long story is that we have an invitation to go to Zambia next July to teach a brand-new course on biblical geography and using visual images in sermons. The class is so new, the course material is still being written. Pastor Andy is re-writing and re-packaging the course material now.


We are prayerfully considering the 2019 opportunity ... and standing amazed at the thought of "taking Israel" to a most unexpected place.

March filming trip

Last March, we had a remarkably successful drone-video filming trip. This shot of Pastor Andy and photographer William Haun working on a cliff in Wadi Qumran was taken from one of Chris Dunn's amazing drones.

We'd like to return on another drone-video trip with Chris and William next March. Besides gathering more footage for our presentations, this trip will produce videos specifically designed for the Friends of Israel. **Budget: \$15,000.**

July: Teaching in Zambia

One of our long-term goals is to train pastors and other Bible teachers how to use images from the land of the Bible in their own ministries. Who would have ever imagined our first invitation would have come from a small seminary in South Africa?

If we can raise the funds, this trip would be for both Pastor Andy and his wife, Melody. She would work in an eye clinic that sees 140 patients a day during the same time period. **Budget: \$10,000.**



New equipment

Our current screen and projector combination is showing some significant wear-and-tear. New laser projectors will help us have a brighter, more consistent image (no white light in the middle of the screen) in daylight settings. While screens are relatively inexpensive, laser projectors are not. We'll need a huge December offering to allow us to make the upgrades. And as we seek more invitations to churches, prisons, schools and orphanages, we'll be dependent upon the generosity of our supporters. **Budget: \$20,000.**
